1.1 What We Do

We are a non-profit 501(c)(3) youth sports organization committed to delivering the top community-based soccer development program to local young athletes. Based in North County San Diego, we provide a competitive and safe training environment for players ranging from 6 to 18 years old. In addition to regular practices, our professional coaches offer clinics and specialized camps tailored to every age and level of play.

1.2 Our Mission

Our mission is to provide a positive environment for athletes, in which we build confidence and develop strengths necessary for success both on and off the field. We strive to inspire a sense of joy in playing the game of soccer along with a dedication to community, integrity and humility in our everlasting pursuit of excellence.

1.3 Our Program

We have 23 teams and over 300 athletes that play in both the Presidio and San Diego Development Academy (SDDA) leagues. The teams will also play in soccer tournaments throughout Southern California and may, at times, travel outside the state. Throughout the year, our program includes the following for our young athletes:

- Training 3x Each Week (2x for 2011/2012 players)
- Speed and Agility Training
- Saturday Scrimmages (intra- and inter-club)
- Spring Futsal
- Optional Spring Break Camp
- 2 to 6 Summer Tournaments (as determined by coach/team/age group)
- Team Summer Camp
- Special Focus on Technical Training
- Position-specific Training
- SDDA or Presidio League Play
- Fall Futsal
- Post Season – CalSouth State Cup (as determined by coach/team)

Chapter 3 – Frequently Asked Questions

1. How are sponsorship funds utilized?

We believe every child with passion and a dedication to competitive soccer should have the opportunity to play. Sponsorship funds are used for need-based financial scholarships for players unable to meet the club registration fee and other financial commitments.

2. How many registered players are in your region?

We currently have over 300 athletes within our Matrix program and 800 within our AYSO Core program.

3. Will the sponsor's name be on uniforms?

Platinum level sponsor names will be included on the practice jersey, but not the game jersey. Guidelines for what we can and cannot put on jerseys are dictated by the national AYSO office.

4. How many people will see my business name?

Your business will be promoted to 1,100 players, their fans and other players and spectators from opposing teams.
